Superintendent Annual Report to Dallas School Board

January 28, 2020

As required by OAR 581-022-1610 Operating Policies and Procedures, all Oregon school districts must report to their respective communities as to the district's status with regards to the state standards, **ALL** of the Division 22 Oregon Administrative Rules, and by February 1, 2020. Following our comprehensive review, I have discovered uncertainty in one standard in which we may not be fully compliant.

Standard 2050 – Human Sexuality Education

As a component of this standard, we are required to provide four age-appropriate instructional sessions per year on child sexual abuse prevention to all students in grades Kindergarten through grade 12. Our review determined that this component may not be fully instructed at all elementary grade levels. As a plan of correction, the district will undertake a review of our human sexuality education curriculum to determine any missing instructional requirements related to child sexual abuse prevention. Any corrections will be made in time for implementation during the 2020-2021 school year.

In addition, I want to comment on **Standard 2060, Comprehensive Guidance and Counseling**. While we are in compliance with this rule, we do not meet the student to counselor ratio of 250 to 1, as recommended in the rule. While this ratio is a recommendation only, I believe it to be an important consideration during the 2020-21 budget development process.

Otherwise, based upon my review I am reporting to the Dallas School District Board and the public that this school district is in compliance with and implementing all remaining applicable standards for public elementary and secondary schools in the state of Oregon as set in OAR Chapter 581, Division 22.
